



Key attribute = control




20th century Governance






U-City concept (Korea)

- U-City: u means ubiquitous and stands for the use of technology to address the core urbanization challenges (land/housing, traffic, disaster prevention and recovery, crime, pollution, energy, community) and to connect the public services verticals with each other and with the private sector and the citizens to create a resilient, sustainable and human oriented urban space.
- U-City operations are managed in an Integrated Operation Center and bundled in a **Public-Private Co-operation Company** (reflecting a partnered governance model).



Planetary Skin Institute (Brazil)

- Planetary Skin Institute (PSI) was set up by **Cisco and NASA** to address complex issues of resource scarcity.
- PSI and **Brazil's Ministry of Science, Technology & Innovation (MCTI)** announced Nov 2011 in Durban that they are undertaking a major multi-year collaborative R&D program to fast track the development of Brazil's **National Early Warning System** for Natural Disasters, before scaling this capability Latin-America wide.
